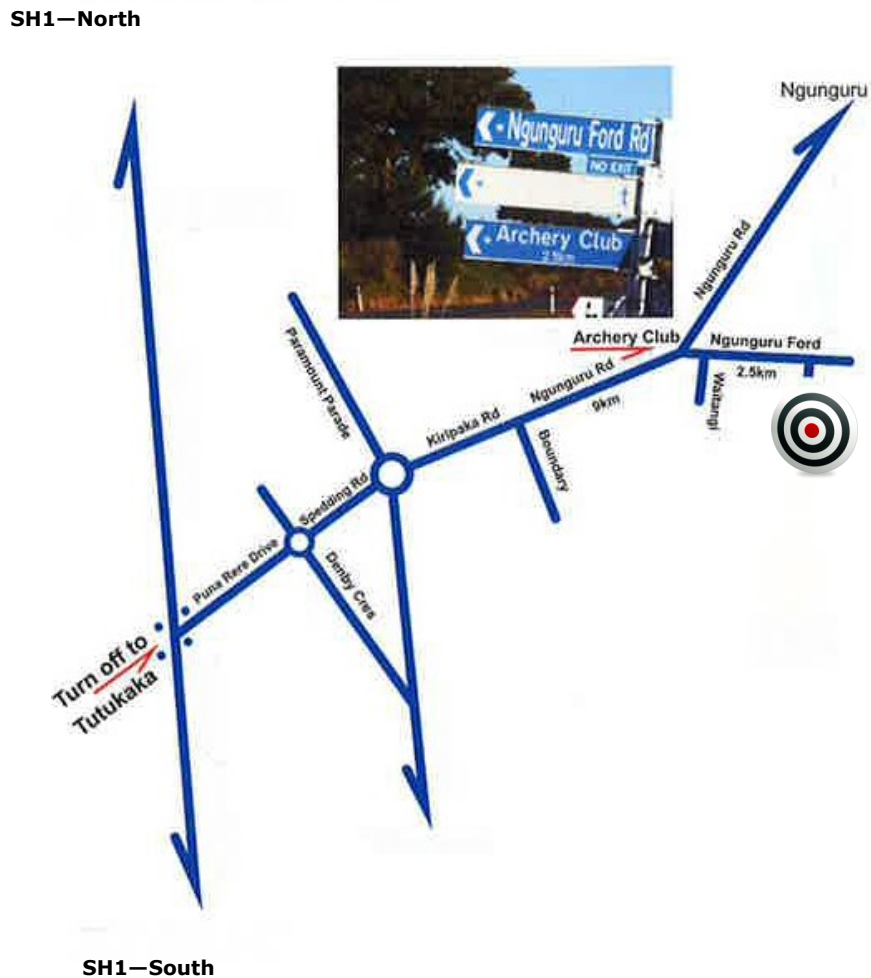

# How to find us.....



From Whangarei – Stay on SH1 going north, follow signs to Whangarei Falls and/or Tutukaka Coast. Ngunguru Ford Rd is on right approx 10 km from Whangarei Falls.

‘Archery club’ is signposted from Ngunguru Rd —club driveway is at 248 Ngunguru Ford Rd—on right.  
Go through forestry gate, club is approx 1km down metal road.



# Mt Tiger Archers

## *Traditional Shoot*

### Information for entrants

#### Eligibility

- This is an open tournament for archers shooting traditional archery equipment only
- This means no compound bows, and no sights on any bow.
- Any arrows are acceptable.
- Recurves, Longbows, Horsebows, Historical, Stickbows are welcome.

#### Divisions

- Longbow: Mens, Ladies, Junior
  - Recurve: Mens, Ladies, Junior
  - Specialties: All entrants in one division
  - Cubs and Peewees; (depending on numbers) recurve and longbow shoot in same division.
- We reserve the right to combine divisions if entry numbers are low.

#### Entry Fee

- Seniors; \$25 per day (\$40 per weekend)
- Juniors/Cubs/ Peewees; \$15 per day (\$30 per weekend)
- Family; \$70 per weekend—2 adults and 2 junior/cub. (\$50 per day)
- Gilligans will be available to buy so you can redeem your lousy shots

#### The Course

- It will be a long walk target course including novelty targets on Saturday
- 20 targets plus specialties on Sunday
- The course is set out so as archers pass the clubhouse, they can stop for lunch. The archers will pass the clubhouse twice during the round.
- Archers must be off the course by 4pm on Saturday
- **Both days score count toward competition total**

The course may be muddy. Gumboots and wet weather clothing is recommended.

#### Other Information

- 10am Muster on Saturday,
- 9am muster on Sunday
- There will be drinks, snacks and lunch available to purchase on both days.
- We do not have eftpos, cash will be needed
- **Bring some old arrows for those 'tricky' targets!**
- **Our legendary dinner will be available on Saturday evening at \$15 per head; \$8 for the little people.**
